

SHELBY COUNTY MASONIC SCHOLARSHIP

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant must be a resident of Shelby County or a student in a Shelby County school.
 2. Applicant must be the child or grandchild of a Master Mason in good standing.
 3. Applicant's belief and behavior should conform to basic Masonic ideals:
 - Belief in God
 - Good citizenship
 - Support of country
 - Belief that all persons are created equal
 4. Applicant should be planning a post-secondary educational program at a university, college, community college, technical or trade school.
 5. Applicant must complete the attached application and have it returned by March 31.
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NOTE: A \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded to a student in two parts upon proof of full-time enrollment. One half of the scholarship will be awarded upon graduation from high school and proof of enrollment in a post-secondary education program. The remainder will be awarded upon successful completion of the first semester of college and proof of enrollment in the second.
